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Exemplary student who always demonstrates respect, responsibility, integrity and fairness. Determined student who inspires others to succeed in their learning.
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Successful student who consistently demonstrates respect, responsibility, integrity and fairness, following all non-negotiables. Consistently contributes positively to the learning environment, actively participating in class activities.
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Engaged student who regularly achieves success by demonstrating respect, responsibility, integrity and fairness, following most non-negotiables. Interacts appropriately, respectfully and positively with students and staff most of the time. Usually contributes positively to the learning environment, participating in class activities and working towards their personal goals.
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Inconsistent student who needs prompting to follow classroom non-negotiables and to stay on task. Relies on prompting to participate in class activities and needs external motivation to work towards growth in learning.
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Disruptive student who regularly interrupts the learning of others and regularly does not follow the non-negotiables. Interactions with students and staff require constant direction to model appropriate behaviours.
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A non-compliant student who does not follow non-negotiables. Does not participate in class activities and is not working towards growth in their learning. Interactions with students and staff are disrespectful and inappropriate.
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Student has not attended class and is not able to be scored
